County of San Bernardino Department of Public Health Hosts Free Flu Vaccination Clinics

San Bernardino. The County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health Preparedness and Response Program is hosting three **free** simultaneous mass **flu vaccination clinics on Thursday, December 1, 2011** as part of the 2011 Simultaneous Mass Influenza Vaccination Exercise.

These one-time free flu vaccination clinics are designed as a learning environment for the Department and Emergency Response partners to exercise plans and procedures for a local pandemic influenza response. The goal of the exercise is to test the Department's mass distribution of prophylaxis and vaccinations to County residents through simultaneous flu clinics.

The **December 1, 2011** Simultaneous Mass Influenza Vaccination Clinic Exercise will be conducted at the following locations and times:

The **free flu vaccinations** will be available to people **two years and older**, a parent or guardian must accompany children under 18 years of age.

- Children under nine (9) years of age may require two (2) doses of flu vaccine (4 weeks apart) based on prior vaccination history.
- Seasonal FluMist will be provided to healthy school-age children only.
- Pregnant women will be offered a flu shot on a first come, first serve basis due to limited supply.
- **These locations will not be offering flu vaccine to infants six (6) to twenty-four (24) months.**
